Balancing the Budget



We have a moral obligation to balance the budget. My first year in Congress I forced Congress to vote on a balanced budget amendment to the Constitution, and I continue to be a vocal co-sponsor of H.J.Res.55, Proposing a balanced budget amendment to the Constitution of the United States. To me, the greatest threat facing our nation is our national debt, which becomes worse every year when we refuse to balance the budget. That's why I've cast tough votes in Congress to reign in government spending. I'll always stand for what is right, no matter what. My record shows that I don't just talk about balancing the budget like most politicians; I actually vote

against legislation that would increase our national debt even if unpopular. That's why the National Taxpayers Union (NTU) honored me with their "Taxpayers' Friend Award." This award is given annually based on actual votes, not just rhetoric, that affect taxes, spending, and debt. This year I was ranked 2nd out of 435 House members.

As governor, I'll restore our independence and freedom by aggressively pursuing fiscally prudent policies for Idaho, reducing Idaho's reliance on federal aid, and continuing work to pass a Balanced Budget Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.
